The City of New York Releases Covered Building List for 2017

Under the NYC Benchmarking Law, owners of tax lots with single buildings greater than 50,000 sq. ft. or multiple buildings totaling more than 100,000 sq. ft. are required to benchmark their energy and water use annually. A list of properties that are required to comply prior to May 1, 2017 can be found [here](#), and the 2017 template that you should use to report your benchmarking results will be found [here](#) effective February 14th.
